GENERAL INFORMATION

FUZE is a superior organosilicone surfactant developed for water-based herbicides in agriculture, horticulture, industrial, turf and forestry applications. It is designed for quick spreading and wetting, uniform droplet distribution and absorption on leaf and stem surfaces. FUZE may be used with most pesticides and fertilizer products. Care must be taken in treating sensitive crops during periods when plants are subjected to drought stress, high temperatures, and high humidity. Disclaimer: Always refer to the label of the pesticide before using FUZE or any other product.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: Do not apply directly to water, or to areas where surface water is present, or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Do not contaminate water when cleaning equipment or disposing of equipment water waters.

FIRST AID

Aerial Application: When applying aerially, follow pesticid label directions including minimum water volume per acre. Do not substitute FUZE for water required by the pesticide label. FUZE is not recommended for aquatic applications.

MIXING: Mixing and application equipment must be cleaned according to cleaning directions on labels of pesticide used before application. Fill tank 2/3 to 3/4 full of water, then begin agitation. Add an antifoam to the spray tank before pesticides, nutrients and/or FUZE are included. Consult the pesticide and/or fertilizer labels for recommended sequence of addition. While agitating, add FUZE and mix for 1 to 2 minutes with lower than normal agitation. Continue filling tank while agitating. For most effective results, apply within 36 hours after mixing.

STORAGE: Store product in original container only, away from other pesticides, fertilizers, food or feed. Do not use, spill, or store near heat or open flame. Keep this container closed when not in use and take care to prevent any water from being introduced to the contents
