GENERAL INFORMATION

MIXMASTER™ is a 55% active alcohol ethoxylate phosphate ester designed for use as an anionic compatibility agent. When used as a compatibility agent in liquid fertilizer-pesticide spray mixtures, **MIXMASTER®** improves the dispersion and uniformity of tank mix ingredients. **MIXMASTER®** may be used with pesticides registered for use on all agricultural, forestry, industrial, non-cropland, rights-of-way, turf, municipal, and other uses. Disclaimer: Always refer to the label of the pesticide before using **MIXMASTER®** or any other product.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Use **MIXMASTER®** at the rate of 1-2 pints per 100 gallons of liquid nitrogen/pesticide tank mixture. Prior to pesticide applications, clean mixing and application equipment according to the pesticide label directions. It is recommended to add **MIXMASTER®** to the fertilizer with agitation on before adding the pesticide. Apply immediately after mixing. If allowed to stand for an extended period of time, ensure that the tank mix is agitated again before using.

SPINDLE CLEANER: Rate 6 oz. per 50 gals of water in spindle water tank. Add **MIXMASTER®** when tank is half full of water, mix thoroughly while continuing to fill tank with circulation or by stirring. When using **MIXMASTER®** for the first time, it is recommended to clean the spindle tank once, with **MIXMASTER®** prior to field use.

ACIDIFYING AGENT

Highly alkaline water (pH of 8 or higher):

8 - 16 oz per 100 gallons of spray solution.

Mildly alkaline / acidic (pH 6.5 - 8):

4 - 8 oz per 100 gallons of spray solution.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

STORAGE: Store product in original container only, away from other pesticides, fertilizers, food or feed. Do not use, spill, or store near heat or open flame. Keep this container closed when not in use and take care to prevent any water from being introduced to the contents of this container.

DISPOSAL: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Triple rinse container and pour rinsate into spray tank. Do not reuse container.
